#### TREASURER REPORT FOR 2024

We currently have a total of \$10,162.81 in the Chase Bank account, \$8,477.77 is in the general fund and \$1,685.04 is in the repeater fund.

The Chase account matches the Treasurer's spreadsheet.

The 2024, closing Chase Bank balance is \$1,208.56 less than the opening balance.

In 2024 we received \$3,336.05 for the general fund and \$156.00 for the repeater fund, for a total of \$3,492.05.

We paid out \$3,842.20 from the general fund and \$858.41 from the repeater fund for a total of \$4,700.61.

We received \$896 from members for the Christmas party and we were billed \$1,039.45, resulting in a cost of \$143.45 to the club.

The Country Store brought in \$1,503.00 from the sale of equipment.

We paid out \$970.00 to Continental Storage.

The club has 120 members.
